- Partners Best Ball – Lowest score from either player on each hole then totaled for one 18 hole score or one 9 hole score. For boys 10-11 and girls 10-12 a minimum of 3 scores must be from the tour member. For all other age groups, a minimum of 6 scores must be recorded from a tour member.
- Competition among age groups will be regarded as a regular season event and Player of the Year points will be awarded accordingly.
- All male adults will play from the men’s white tees and all females will play from the forward tees.
- Medallions will be awarded at the Founders Cup Championship for both winning team members.
